
## March 2022 Ministry Update

Hello Friends & Family!



Today I want to share another “door” for ministry that God has recently opened. A very unexpected door... Podcasts! A few years ago, I had the opportunity of being interviewed on a couple of education-related podcasts. With the release of my book last summer and the subsequent attention it has received from magazines such as *Forbes*, *eSchoolNews*, *The Knowledge Review*, and others, many additional opportunities have been provided.



Last fall, just before the holidays, I was invited to be a guest on a leadership podcast. Before this opportunity, I have probably only listened to a couple of podcasts like this. (They have not been a part of my life or daily routine). However, it has been eye-opening to learn how many leadership podcasts there are and what a large listenership there is worldwide.



Over the past few months, a week has not passed that I have not found myself being interviewed by various leadership and school-based podcasters. In fact, **as a result of one of the podcasts, I was invited to conduct a site visit and provide leadership training** for board members and administrators of a charter school. 


