We have been delightfully surprised by how they are engaging in their discussion groups, challenging & encouraging each other, and being authentic in the growing process! What we are all experiencing is that the more we truly understand who God is and experience His presence, forgiveness & empowering grace, we are beginning to desire to live more holy lives. Obligation, legalism, "ought to's", and duty are crummy motivators, but tasting and experiencing the goodness of the Lord and His mighty love are transforming us and our standards!

As we continue talking about this in Badger Life, we are also diving into the topic of holiness at a deeper level with our core group of student leaders! The hope is to equip them more as they are coming alongside the rest of the group in the battle for holiness. The 14 of them have been reading a book by Nancy Leigh DeMoss with us called, Holiness. It is part of a trilogy that focuses on brokenness, surrender and holiness... we'd definitely recommend it! We have been SO encouraged by the things they are processing together in our growth group!
