embracing the environment of discipleship & community that encourages them to grow as young men spiritually.





  - Being motivated by God's never-changing love & grace
  - Embracing an Identity in Christ- seeing ourselves in light of how God sees us, through the truths in the Bible
  - Spiritual Gifts
  - The role of the Holy Spirit in our faith journeys
  - Spiritual Disciplines- prayer, reading the Bible, evangelism, fasting & solitude
  - Submitting to God in the midst of trials & suffering
  - Having an eternal perspective- living in light of the hope we have and allowing our lives to point others to Him.
