Would you pray for me? **Pray that I may not seek identity in the "doing" of ministry but rather the "being" a redeemed son of the most high God.** I'm becoming more convinced that all of life is a matter of stewardship and when I arrive on the shores of eternity I want to hear God say, "Well done, good and faithful servant." That is the ultimate goal for us all.
