"I was involved with youth group and led worship, but I'm not really interested in Bible study. I just want to focus on school; that's why I'm here." My heart sank, but then God's Spirit quickly gave me discernment that Adam was living a doublelife for many years and was tired of "playing" Christianity. "I can understand that" I responded. I began to share my story with Adam and the others about how my freshman year God took away everything I held dear (athletic ability, friends) and exposed my heart to deeper fulfillment in Christ. "I finally realized that knowing the living God was the most meaningful thing, not just pretending like I knew Him." It was incredible to watch Adam's face change before my eyes as he wrestled with that thought. Every freshman that I meet is in such a critical phase of life, struggling to find significance in something or someone. I often will see it happening literally in the moment. 2 Corinthians 4 tells us that God shines the light of the knowledge of his glory in the face of Jesus. Pray with me that the Spirit opens every single heart of the 4,000+ freshmen to see God's glory in the gospel.
