This is typically the most exciting and tiring part of the year. We are weeks into reaching out and relaunching movements on five campuses in Southern Wisconsin, and we are thrilled at what the Lord has done.

Since last Spring we've been praying that this freshman class would be the most spiritually open ever. We've wanted to get in the paths of students to give them opportunities over and over again to hear the Good News. We hosted tons of events from a root beer house party to Spike ball and Volleyball tournaments, to Italian Soda and survey tables to bonfires.

We've passed out thousands of pom poms with links to online spiritual interest surveys, chalked about our meetings on sidewalks across campus, conversed with people on social media, and texted myriads of phones to let people know we are on campus and interested in giving them a good place to consider faith. It's been our ambition to find ways to pull up a chair with students, find out about their spiritual perspectives, and offer them the opportunity to consider the person of Christ.

Many times, we can't measure the results of what we do. And other times we are blown away by the results. At Madison, 3000 students filled out our spiritual interest survey, a record 93 teams played in our volleyball tournament, and 337 people attended our first Badger Cru weekly meeting.

At Whitewater, 1000 people filled out surveys, 15 teams played volleyball, and a record 257 people came out to the first meeting! In its third year. We've also seen growth at Beloit College with 34 people participating in their gathering.

Through large group meetings like these, small group Bible studies, and multitudes of personal conversations, the Gospel has been taught repeatedly on campus.

Celebrate with us that people are saying "Yes" to Jesus. In just the first few weeks of school, over 50 students and 1 faculty member have told us that after hearing the gospel they put their trust in Christ!
